The ideal candidate will recognise the balance needed with visitor experience and top animal welfare

You must:

- Have experience with animals (including large animals)
- Be hard-working and willing to muck in
- Be dedicated, with good time-keeping skills
- Have a positive can-do attitude
- Two years animal experience minimum and some leading experience

The role:

- Supervising our staff & volunteers, ensuring roles are carried out correctly and effectively.
- Ensuring our volunteers are well looked after
- Supervising the health and well-being of our residents
- Recruitment to deliver a hard working, professional team.
- Working with the management to deliver a staff and volunteer rewards program.
- Monitoring and completing health records for the animals.
- Helping with the general day-to-day care of the animals including (but not limited to): cleaning, feeding, watering, and other animal care duties e.g. veterinary care/treatment, monitoring, weighing
- Assisting with monitoring health and safety
- Responsible for management duties when management is off-site
- Monitoring feed, bedding, general materials, petrol etc.
- To deal with grievances and disciplinaries in line with company policies
- Making sure everyone is treated correctly in line with company policies
- Encourage staff and volunteers to grow in a positive and constructive manner
- Making sure the sanctuary is clean, safe, and ready for public, staff, and volunteers
- Helping coordinate our seasonal staff
- Helping with events as part of our management team, including brainstorming new ideas
